Where is the Festival?

Waterfoot Wakes is spread across several venues
 - Horse + Bamboo, outside The Old Library Cafe,
 Mytholme Play Area - and new venue this year,
 Choice Indian Street Food.

Is it Accessible?

Nearly all events this year at Waterfoot Wakes are held in fully wheelchair accessible venues. Our venues are ground floor level and have disabled toilets. For more access information, please head to : horseandbamboo.org/wakesaccessinfo

What Does 'Pay What You Can' Mean? (PWYC**)

This means that you can donate any amount for your ticket. Whilst we do have ticket prices listed against all of our events - Pay What You Can tickets are available for all of our events, whether booking online or walking in. We do this so that everyone is able to attend and enjoy our events.

Where is Food & Drink Available?

There are some fantastic shops and cafes selling food & drink in Waterfoot including The Old Library Cafe & Choice Indian Street Food, who are both venues for this year's festival.

In addition - food will be available 12pm onwards on both Saturdays of the festival from Horse + Bamboo. Horse + Bamboo's cafe will be open for hot, cold & alcoholic drinks, as well as cakes & sweet treats, throughout Waterfoot Wakes from 10am - 3pm daily.
